## Çan / Çanakkale / Turkey 14th – 20th October 2012.

## First day:

We left Hódmezővásárhely at 6 o'clock early in the morning. Everybody was very excited about the "big trip". First we went to Budapest to the airport. Our plane took off at 10:50. The view was wonderful, besides we got a delicious Turkish lunch. The flight was only two hours, we landed in Atatürk Airport, Istanbul.
