Fourth day:

I'm sure that we made hundreds of pictures there. After the lunch in Çanakkale we went to Troy to visit the wooden horse. We could go inside the horse, it was really interesting. Finally we went to Assos. When we got there even then I could see the sunset behind the mountains. Several sellers were in the streets, they sold their things at a low price. After that tiring day we ate dinner in Çan with our host students and their friends.

Fifth day:

On Thursday there was a talking about the next meeting and we got presents from the teachers and the students. After lunch we visited the Cheramics Factory in Çan. We could see how they make cheramics and tiles. In the evening the students and the teachers organised a farewell party. The mothers of the students prepared homemade local foods .The children performanced Turkish folk music for us. At the end of the party everybody was very sad, because of the leave-taking.

Sixth day:

We said good bye from the students, the teachers and Çan. After an all-day trip we stayed at a hotel in Istanbul. Everybody was very hungry so we ate a dinner in the hotel.

Seventh day:

After a short breakfast we went to to city center. The Blue Mosque, the Aya Sofya and the Sultan's Palace were incredibly wonderful. I spent the rest of my money in Istanbul, I bought some souvenirs to my family. Unfortunately we had to go home so the taxi took us back to the airport. On the plane we ate our last Turkish dinner.

Above all I'm sure that it was the best tarvelling of my life. I met with very kind students. Because of their religion the people are respectful and reliable. I learnt many turkish words in that one week. I hope that I can go back once...
